

CLEAR-SPRING STUD

Mrs Sarah Nisbet, Hilton College, Hilton, established the Clear-Spring Stud in 1985 and bought the mare Ismont Tympani (f1984 Torbry Andre x Spasido Marimba) from J te Riele. In 1986 she bought the mare Brackenwood Misty Moon (f1982 Torbry Andre x Lottesmore Misty Morning) from her breeder Judy Stuart. She was in foal to Judy's Bukkenburg Bob (Coed Coch Nerog x Bukkenburg Bonnet) and her first foal with her prefix was the colt Clear-Spring Moonshine which was born on 14 September, 1987, which was sold to McPhie Morgan of the Agha Stud in 1988.

In 1989 two foals arrived. On 18 October the colt Clear-Spring Dare-The-Moon arrived. He was a full brother to Misty Moon, and in 1990 was sold to her daughter in law Denise Nisbet who decided to have her own stud (*see article on the Amangwe Stud on p78*). On 11 November Clear-Spring Drum Dancer was born. She was by Bukkenburg Bob out of Ismont Tympani and was sold to Robin Aberdeen in 1990.

A full sister to Moonshine and Dare-The-Moon, Clear-Spring Moon Dreamer was born on 13 October 1991 and was kept. The last foal bred by the stud was Clear Spring Carol of the Drum born on 17 December, 1992, a filly out of Ismont Tympani by Judy Stuart's Brackenwood Red Robin and she was sold to a family in Hammersley.
